The weekly rates are an average of the rates actually paid by TasBuild to employees taking an entitlement during the subject month. The weekly rates paid have been calculated in accordance with the requirements of the Act and the Rules of the Fund. In general terms the rates represent the ordinary weekly amount payable to the employee and do not include site specific or other various compensatory allowances.

Return Lodgement - Reminders

In response to requests from a number of employers we introduced an email and letter reminder that Returns were due to be lodged.

This action was introduced as a service to employers to assist them with their compliance obligations and to avoid increased costs that accrue where Returns are lodged after the due dates.

These reminders are being sent to all employers and should not be construed as being sent to you due to non compliance.

We are simply responding to the request of a number of employers who have indicated that a reminder sent prior to the due date for the lodgement of Returns would assist them to comply with their obligations.
