The weekly rates are an average of the rates actually paid by TasBuild to employees taking an entitlement during the subject month. The weekly rates paid have been calculated in accordance with the requirements of the Act and the Rules of the Fund. In general terms the rates represent the ordinary weekly amount payable to the employee and do not include site specific or other various compensatory allowances.

Internet Return Lodgement.

“Use your computer to save time”

Do you know that you can complete your Monthly or Quarterly Employer Return on-line?

Over **60 percent of registered TasBuild Employers** lodge their Returns this way!

The information required to complete the Return can be entered straight from your keyboard, providing significant savings in time and stationery.

Employers who lodge on-line get a reminder email on or around the 22nd day of the subject month advising that the Return is available. The email contains a link to the TasBuild web site, all they do is click the link and ‘log in’.

Once logged in, Returns are listed on the left side of the page. Their current Return is identified as the ‘unlodged’ Return. They then simply click on ‘open/update’ which opens the Return and they complete it in the same manner as a paper Return, providing information for each of their listed employees.

Once the information has been entered they then click ‘submit return to Tasbuild’, which is just above their name on the screen and this will send the Return through to TasBuild. Upon receipt an invoice is issued.

As you can see **electronic lodgement** of Returns is easy and quick, saves time and it can be done on the spot. There is no need to run to the post office to put your Return in the mail or to send a fax.
